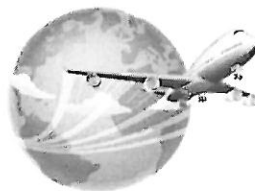

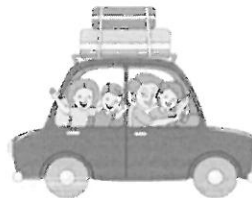


Traveling this summer?

How to Balance your Checking Account

The point of balancing your account is to make sure you and the bank agree on how much money you have. This means you need to keep a record of your spending. The best and easiest way to do this is to write every transaction in a register or on a spreadsheet and keep a running balance.

To get started, take the ending balance on your statement or online banking. Add in any deposits and subtract any withdrawals or other transactions that do not appear on the statement. Make sure that everything on your statement is included on your checkbook register.

The ending number should match the balance in your register.

If the numbers do not match, you've probably forgotten to record a transaction. Look over your statement and try again. If you see a mistake, please notify your bank immediately.

If it's been a while since you've balanced or you have never kept a register, it may take a few tries to get it right.

Keep trying or ask your banker for help!

One last tip!

Don't rely solely on the ATM or Online banking balance. This is only a snapshot of how much is in your account at that exact moment.

It will not reflect any transactions that have not posted to your account yet.
